WHITE WINE SELECTION:

AUSTRALIAN:

109. Wolf Blass – President's Selection Chardonnay 2006 €36.00

An aroma of buttery ripe fruit with a lovely vanilla oak complexity.
On taste, the wine has a harmonious fruit & oak balance with a full
flavoured soft finish.

110. Yarraman, Black Cypress, Sauvignon Blanc €28.50

Fresh and zesty with layers of tropical and herbal flavours through
the mid palate, displaying excellent fruit weight and varietal character.

ARGENTINIAN:

111. Septima, Chardonnay/Semillion 2006 €25.00

Pale yellow colour with an aroma of apple & tropical fruit. It is fruity, fresh
& silky in the mouth.

CHILEAN:

112. Carta Vieja, Sauvignon Blanc 2007 €25.00

Pale yellow colour, bright and clear green overtones. Fruity and complex
in aroma, slight presence of wood. In the mouth it is citric, fresh, with a
well pronounced varietal character. Developed wood, round, long
persistence and harmonic.

SOUTH AFRICAN:

113. Zonnebloem – Chardonnay – 2006 €23.00

Bright, pale gold in colour with a rich fruit aroma & layers of oaky
vanilla, with a biscuity complexity. On taste the rich style follows
through with a ripe lemon edge & a depth of buttery fudge rich overtones.

114. Durbanville Hills – Sauvignon Blanc – 2007 €28.00

Full tropical fruit flavours with gooseberries, figs & a hint of grass.
Full-bodied & fresh.

FRENCH:

115. Macon Lugny- Paul Beaudet – 2005 €28.00

One of France's most popular white Burgundys & it isn't difficult to see why.
A rich flowery nose of roasted nuts & butter is followed on the palate by
honey, apple, tropical fruits & a pleasing nutty finish.

116. Chablis, Domaine Long Depaquit AC 2006 €30.00

From one of the top growers in Chablis, this wine is acclaimed by
many wine writers. It is a full flavoured wine with a distinctive nose
& smooth texture.

117. Pouilly Fume, Château Favray – 2007 €40.00

A crisp dry white with a hint of gooseberry & great finesse.

118. Sancerre "Le Coteau" AC 2006 €35.00

Classic dry white wine from the Loire Valley. Dry yet fragrant, with lots of

Fruit & a fresh clean gooseberry flavour.

ITALIAN:

- 119. Pinot Grigio, Zonin - 2006** €29.00
The bouquet is fruity, relatively full, unusually fine & the flavour is soft, fresh & light tending towards a dry style.
- 120. Cossetti Gavi di Gavi** €32.00
This wine is bone dry with high acid levels but has enough ripe fruit to balance the wine. Rich sweet fruit on the nose with a crisp dry finish, lovely mouthfeel and aftertaste.
- NEW ZEALAND**
- 121. Montana Reserve Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2006** €29.50
Fresh, distinctive gooseberry flavours, are enhanced with rich lush tropical fruit. Strikingly intense gooseberry & tropical fruit flavours are well-balanced with crisp acidity, with a lingering finish.
- 122. Kahurangi – Riesling – 2005** €25.00
A refined wine with subtle fruit characters deserving of reserve status. Medium in style this wine exhibits a hint of residual sweetness with traditional Moutere citrus characters.
- 123. Kahurangi – Un-wooded Chardonnay – 2002** €34.50
Tropical fruit flavours of pineapple with some peach tones have produced a fresh, fruity wine with a full palate.

CHAMPAGNE:

- 124. Dom Perignon** €180.00
World famous luxury Cuvee from Mœt et Chandon. Rich full, biscuity aroma follows through with a depth of mature buttery style.
- 125. Mœt & Chandon Brut Imperial N.V** €75.00
Elegant, rich buttery Chardonnay aroma with hints of "toast" with a delicate buttery, round flavour & smooth aftertaste.
- 126. Mœt & Chandon Brut Imperial Rose N.V** €85.00
Medium pink in colour with a discrete lime & hawthorn blossom nose & a slight hint of blackcurrants, culminating in a slightly fruity finish.
- 127. Mœt & Chandon Brut Imperial Vintage, 2000** €100.00
Medium golden yellow chardonnay, pinot noir & pinot mernier. Its aroma consists of dried fruits, barley sugar & ripe wheat. It is well balanced & supple on the palate.
- 128. Perrier Jouet grand brut N.V** €85.00
Pale golden yellow with a very honied ripe fruit aroma of vanilla biscuits & bramley apple fruit with a warm brioche complexity, mature, fresh style of ripe citrus & grapefruit with a rich warm bread & marmalade complexity.
- 129. Mœt & Chandon Brut Imperial N.V. Snipe** €20.00
Elegant, rich buttery Chardonnay aroma with hints of "toast" with a delicate buttery, round flavour & smooth aftertaste.

SPARKLING WINE:

- 130. Wolf Blass Red Label Chardonnay/ Pinot Noir N.V.** €40.00
Soft buttery tropical fruit and ripe melon aroma with a refreshing
Taste of ripe honeyed fruit with a juicy rich finish.

RED WINE SELECTION:

AUSTRALIAN:

- 131. Wolf Blass – President's Selection Cabernet Sauvignon 2005**
€36.00 Deep ruby purple in colour with an intense rich blackcurrant aroma
with creamy oak & minty fruit overtones.

- 132. Wyndham Estate Bin 555 – Shiraz** €25.50
A medium to full bodied traditional Shiraz with distinct, rich plum &
Pepper characters. Parcels of the ripe fruit flavours are complexed by oak
Tannins, as result of maturation in oak hogsheads for up to 15 months,
Leaving a smooth, lasting finish.

- 133. Wyndham Estate Bin 888 – Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot** €25.50
Bin 888 displays ripe blackcurrant, cassis, cherry & spice characters. The
Elegant & sophisticated palate is enhanced by toasty oak. Blackcurrant &
Smoky, leafy flavours linger on the finish.

ARGENTINIAN:

- 134. Septima, Malbec** €27.50
Dark red colour with intense aromas of sweet fruits such as plums &
Blackberries. Soft tannins with oak & vanilla nuances. Good balance & length.

CHILEAN:

- 135. Carta Vieja, Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve - 2005** €25.00
Intense deep ruby red with shades of violet. Aromas of ripe plums, cassis
With subtle hints of ageing in oak barriques. This wine has a great character
And complexity with an excellent tannin structure balancing perfectly red
Fruits with French oak.

SOUTH AFRICAN:

- 136. Zonnebloem – Cabernet Sauvignon – 2005** €23.00
Bright purple ruby with a soft plum & ripe juicy fruit aroma with an oaky
overtone. On taste, a lovely style of ripe fruit with smoky oak complexity
& an interesting depth of firm, rich fruit.

- 137. Durbanville Hills – Pinotage – 2006** €28.00
Matured in small French Oak barrels with a lingering raspberry flavour
and a smooth, sweet clove bouquet.

FRENCH:

- 138. Châteauneuf du Pape, Vidal Fleury 2006** €57.50
Beautiful deep crimson colour, powerful & complex bouquet with lots of
Spices. A tannic structure which has been rounded & smoky by time spent
In oak. Lots of peppery ripe fruits with a long and pleasant finish.

- 139. Crozes Hermitage, Vidal Fleury 2005** €35.00
A deep garnet-red colour. Penetrating bouquet with lots of spices & ripe
Fruits. Rich, full-bodied, beefy with soft tannins. A long finish recalling
Cinnamon and ripe plums.

- 140.Cotes du Rhone Rouge, Vidal Fleury AC 2006** €28.00
Brilliant garnet-red colour. Red fruits & spices on the nose. The mouth reveals Rounded tannins, a warm full-bodied wine with an uncommon & lasting aromatic Intensity. The proof that Cotes-du-Rhone can be a serious elegant wine.
- 141.Fleurie, Albert Bichot 2006** €32.50
A good full, bright ruby red colour. Very fresh, strong but delicate fruit with Cherry, peach and flower flavours. It is quite round & fleshy with finely Balanced body.
- 142.Château de Pressac 2002** €80.00
Fine wine with form & stature. Well extracted fruit with just a touch of Oak. Reserved, sober with plenty of ripe matiere, balanced and grip on the Finish. Solid and dignified.
- 143.Chateau Chasse Spleen 2001** €85.00
Beautifully ripe fruit, balanced, elegant and polished.
- SPANISH:**
- 144.Campo Viejo Reserva 2003** €27.00
This wine has a garent ruby red with brick coloured rim. It blends aromas Of ripe berries with those of vanilla. A rounded wine, full of flavour.
- 145.Palacio de la Vega, Crianza, Navarra 2002** €24.50
The colour is typically a clear, bright cherry-red and the bouquet shows lifted Spice & powerful red fruits. On the palate, complex fruit flavours are integrated With fine tannins and a persistent, long finish.
- ITALIAN:**
- 146.Chianti Classico, Casa Emma – 2005** €25.50
Medium-bodied red with ripe cherry & a long finish.
- 147.Camparo – Barbera d’Asti 2005** €32.50
Full bodied with a very soft tannin this wine is ideal with red meat as well as game
- NEW ZEALAND:**
- 148.Montana Marlborough Pinot Noir** €26.00
Cherry & plum fruit aromas topped with cinnamon spice & cedary oak. Full with sweet fruit & soft silky tannins, the wine has good length with ripe fruit sweetness.
